**ASAKUSA HANAYASHIKI Amusement Park**

The path is wide, but the road and sidewalk are not clearly separated in some areas.

The sidewalks on Kappabashi Hon-dori St. are flat, but be careful of bicycles.

Wheelchair users should proceed with caution due to crowds.

Contact Jidaiya to reserve a special ramp which allows wheelchair users to smoothly get on and off the rickshaw without navigating steps. (Separate fee required.)

If Nakamise Street is crowded, take one of the parallel streets.
